This practice test is an important event that confirms readiness to administer NAPLAN Online at the school. The practice test runs for 45 minutes and student performance is not assessed.

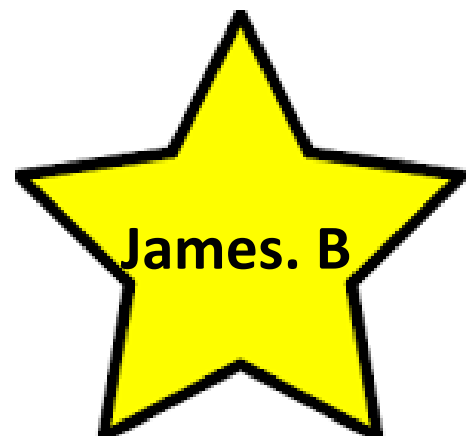

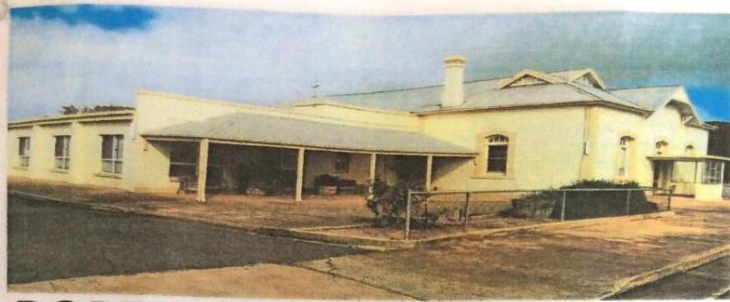
ROBERTSTOWN MARKETS – 14th March 2021

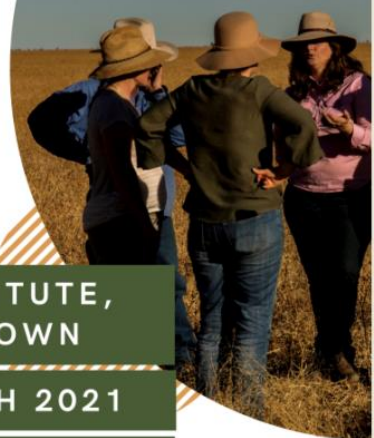

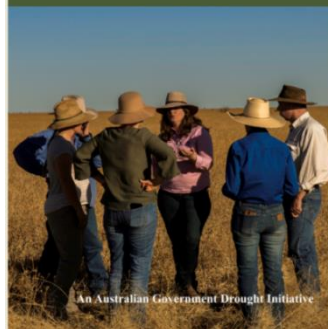
